Awards recognise green cause

The winners of the third edition of Qatar Today Green Awards, described as the nation's first and only environmental awards, were announced at a high-profile event at the Four Seasons Doha hotel.

High-ranking officials, corporate leaders and sustainability and environmental executives from various organisations attended the Qatar Today Green Awards 2010 ceremony in which winners from nine categories were honoured.

The awards were given away by prominent personalities including Yousuf Jassem al-Darwish, chairman of Qatar Today's publisher Oryx Advertising Company, and Qatar Foundation vice chairperson Dr Saif al-Hajari.

In the 'Green Organisation' category, Aecom and United Development Company were the top winners, and Ras Laffan Power Company and Movenpick Towers and Suites were first and second runners up, respectively.

Khalid Cement Industries Complex won the 'Green Innovation' segment, while Innovations Unlimited ME was the first runner up and Johnson Controls the second runner up.

Under the 'Environmental Vision in the Energy Section,' Dolphin Energy was the winner, with Oryx GTL and Topaz Marine Services (Doha Marine Services) emerging as the first and second runners up, respectively.

'Environmental Vision in the Education Sector' saw Qatar Foundation - Hous-

ing and Residence Life as the winner, followed by Qatar University and MES Indian School as first and second runners up, respectively.

Qtel won the award for 'Green Retailer,' and Vodafone and Ebn Sina Medical the first and second runners up, respectively.

In the 'Green Product or Service' category, Al Haya

Waste Management were the winners, followed by Consolidated Gulf Company and Sigma Paints emerging as the first and second runners up, respectively.

Friends of the Environment Centre won the 'Best Public Awareness Campaign,' segment, with Tata Consulting Engineers-

QSTP and Doha Bank be-

coming the first and second runners up, respectively.

In the 'Green Roof and Green Building Design' category, Qatari Diar Vinci Construction was the winner, and Qatargas Operating Company and Energy City Qatar, the first and second runners up, respectively.

The third edition of the awards saw a good par-

ticipation from all sectors, which itself was a clear indication of growing awareness of environmentalism in the country.

Over 80 nominations for nine categories were received from large and small organisations engaged in diverse products and services.

Initiatives included recycling of used equipment, upgrading the education curriculum to include environmental studies and process related eco-endeavours, such as carbon neutral constructions.

Winners under each category were chosen through a two-tier selection process. The selection panel comprised of renowned environmental experts Dr Benno Boer (Unesco), Dr Nobuyuki Yamaguchi (Qatar University), Kanchan Ghoshal (KPMG) and Deena al-Abdullah. Katrin Scholtz-Bärth (Sustainable Qatar) screened every entry.

Applicants who were first short-listed by the judges were then requested to provide detailed information on their initiatives, based on which the final decisions were made.

Besides the ceremony, presentations made by HSBC and Dohaland, the key part-

ners and sponsors of The Green Awards 2010, highlighted the commitment and vision of the companies.
